“1(A). That the respondents be directed to grant the first A.C.P. w.e.f. 05.04.2003 and second A.C.P. w.e.f. 05.04.2013 with economic benefit and interest thereon up-to-date to the petitioner.

(B). The respondents be directed to grant A.C.P. to the petitioner in terms of the order dated 27.09.2011 passed in CWJC No. 9098 of 2009.”
