Programme Officer dated 06.02.2020. The issue is arising out of the selection procedure of Aanganwadi Sevika for Aanganwadi Centre No.22, Kartik Nagar, Bhagalpur, wherein private Respondent No.12 has been selected.

3. Learned counsel for the State raises an objection regarding available remedy of revisional appeal before the Divisional Commissioner under Clause 12 of the Guidelines for Selection of Aanganwadi Sevika/Sahayika, 2019 issued by the Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services.

4. The disputed issues raised by the petitioner in the instant writ proceedings can very well be considered effectively by availing remedy under Clause 12 of the 2019 Guidelines before the Divisional Commissioner (Respondent No.4).

5. If the petitioner chooses to avail the remedy within four weeks, the Divisional Commissioner, Bhagalpur (Respondent No.4) shall proceed and consider the same on merits and pass appropriate orders expeditiously, in accordance with law.

6. Writ application is disposed of.
