2 02-03-2023 Though the present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 02.06.2014, passed in Deficit Stamp Case no. 70 of 2013-14 by the Assistant Inspector General, Registration, Darbhanga, however, at the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to prefer an appeal under ***Section 47(A)(4) of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899***. Liberty so sought, is granted.

within a period of four weeks from today, the appellate authority shall consider the same on merits, without being impeded by the issue of limitation and pass a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, forthwith.
