2 10-05-2023 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a
period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Manjhagarh P.S. Case No. 09 of 2020 registered for the offence
under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a),
38, 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act,
2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 15.02.2023 and there is a recovery
of 398.160 liters of illicit liquor.

Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer
for bail.



Considering the period of custody and the recovery of liquor, this application for regular bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail after framing of charge, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District Judge-II-Cum-Special Excise Court No.-I, Gopalganj in connection with Manjhagarh P.S. Case No. 09 of 2020.
