ORAL ORDER

2 18-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 379,
307, 354, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 15.05.2022 at
09.30 P.M., all the accused persons named in the FIR including
the petitioners started abusing the informant. On protest by the
informant, all the accused persons assaulted him. In the



meantime, co-accused Jitendra Kumar assaulted the informant on his head with iron rod and when his wife came to save her, petitioner no.3 assaulted her with legs and fists. Petitioner no.2 along with one accused Sunil Kumar snatched Rs. 8500/- from the informant's pocket.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. Both the parties are co-villagers. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is specific allegation of assault against one Jitendra Kumar. There is admitted land dispute between the parties. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Bidupur P.S. Case No. 249 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
