following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/rule/ direction commanding the Respondents authorities to make payment of the admitted arrears of salary, dues which was decided/calculated by the respondent authority in the light of revised six pay scale with statutory interest on the all due amount that have not yet paid to the petitioner.”
