2 13-10-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1.(i) That for issuance of appropriate writ order or direction of writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the order dated 03.02.16 under proposal No.46 to the extent it directs dismissal of petitioner from the post of Uddipila upon a



Complaint made by outsider namely Sri Arvind Kumar [a non candidate complainant] alleging that the petitioner was earlier working as Aanganwari Sevika appointed on strength of a Madhma Certificate which was found to be forged as such was removed from service as such alleged that her matriculation certificate of Same session i.e. 2009 appears to be forged as such requested to remove the petitioner from the post of Uddipika & upon such request the respondent No.5 directed removal of the writ petitioner & directed appointment of another candidate happens to be wife of Sri Arvind Kumar itself.

It is relevant herewith to mention that the respondent No.5 had sent the Certificate of petitioner to Bihar School Examination Board Patna for verification & the Bihar School Examination Board reported by letter No.1521 Dated 03.03.16 that the Certificate of the petitioner passed with 2nd Division is genuine.



(ii) That to direct the respondent not to appoint any candidate on the post of Uddipika till the decision of this case."

2. After, some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition, to which the learned counsel for the respondent-State has got no objection.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
