seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That the abovementioned

Sevika on 27.05.2007 through by the chain of Aam Sabha and on 28.5.2007 regarding the appointment of the petitioner has been rejected and the appointment of the Kaushalya Kumari as Respondent No.9 validly selected on the post of Anganwari Sevika in place of petitioner (namely Respondent No.9)."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to challenge the order dated 14.02.2013 passed by the Child Development Project Officer, Benipur, District-Darbhanga, by filing appropriate appeal. Liberty so sought is granted.
