**CORAM: HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE MOHIT KUMAR SHAH**  
**ORAL ORDER**

- 2      09-11-2023                      1. The grievances of the petitioner are regarding non-grant of monetary benefits pertaining to 1<sup>st</sup> ACP as also non-consideration of his case with regard to grant of 2<sup>nd</sup> MACP.
2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the respondent-State has submitted by referring to the counter affidavit, filed in the present case that the petitioner has already been granted the benefit of 1<sup>st</sup> ACP and partial monetary benefits thereof have also been granted, however, the rest of monetary benefit, arising out of the grant of the 1<sup>st</sup> ACP, shall be paid to the petitioner, forthwith.
3. As far as grant of 2<sup>nd</sup> MACP is concerned, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the



same is under consideration and a decision would definitely be taken, expeditiously.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the District Magistrate, Saran at Chapra to make payment of the outstanding amount of the benefits, accrued on account of grant of 1<sup>st</sup> ACP, within a period of two weeks from today and further take a decision with regard to grant of 2<sup>nd</sup> MACP to the petitioner, within a period of six weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
