2 09-11-2023 1.The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing and commanding the respondents to



absorb/rehabilitate the petitioners in regular Government Service on class IV post as per the order dated 11.08.2015 passed by this Hon'ble court in L.P.A. No. 1489/2011 arising out of C.W.J.C. No. 8418/2010 as well as the order dated 03.03.2017 passed by this Hon'ble court in C.W.J.C. No. 384/2017 which was affirmed vide order dated 23.01.2018 passed by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Hon'ble court in L.P.A. No. 1047/2017 as the petitioners are similarly situated candidates likewise the petitioners of C.W.J.C. No. 384/2017, giving the petitioners all legal and consequential benefit.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of their subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
