4 24-01-2023 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s) :-

“(i) Quashing of the decision of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure 2 Series) in connection with Notice Inviting Tender No. 09/2021-22 by which, the Technical Bid of the petitioner has been rejected in terms of Clause 4.8 of the SBD on the ground. that the firm stands debarred;



(ii) Direction upon the Respondent to open the Financial Bid of the petitioner and in case the Bid is technically and financially viable, a consequential direction to allot the work to the petitioner; and
(ii) Restraining the Respondents from finalizing the Tender in connection with NIT No. 09/2021-22 and creating any third party rights during the pendency of the present writ petition.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Permission granted.

The instant petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.

Needless to add with the withdrawal of the present petition, the interim order dated 13.5.2022 stands vacated.
