2 28-03-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1 That the present writ petition is being preferred issuing writ of mandamus for commanding and directing concern authority for consideration and adjudication of claims as represented by petitioner before District Magistrate, Darbhanga settled to encroachment upon lands bearing PWD- Khesra No. 411 Anchal Kusheshwar Asthan, Thana No. 250, District- Darbhanga even by ignoring order passed by Hon'ble High Court disposing C.W.J.C No. 3898 of 2001



disposed off on 14.08.2001 and M.J.C. No. 3094 of 2001 disposed off on 02.04.2004.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies, as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
