Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 379 of the Indian Penal
Code.

F.I.R. was lodged against unknown for theft of
motorcycle of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and his name has transpired during
investigation. He further submits that no stolen motorcycle nor
any incriminating article have been recovered from the
