ORAL ORDER

2 18-10-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That by this writ petition, the petitioners pray for issuance of writ/ writs, Rule/Rules and direction/ directions upon the respondents to consider their case for their absorption or rehabilitation under State Govt. to serve the State according to their education qualification either



Class-III or Class IV post as per the vacancies available, who have worked for more than three years continuously as instructors under non-formal Education Scheme of the State Govt. which has now been abolished.

And any other relief or reliefs for which they be found entitled in law be granted to them.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
