2 05-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Tekari P.S. (Mou OP) Case No. 57 of 2023 registered under
Section 30(A)/41(i)/45 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further he submits that from
perusal of Seizure List, it is apparent that the alleged recovery
has been made from the *hut*. Nothing has been recovered from
the conscious possession of this petitioner. Petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Exclusive Special Excise Court-II, Gaya in connection with Tekari (Mou OP) P.S. Case No. 57 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
