The petitioner has filed the present Cr. Writ Petition
seeking direction from the Court that speedy investigation may
takes place relating to Hathori P.S. Case No. 11 of 2020 lodged
under Sections 302/34 of the I.P.C. read with Section 27 of
Arms Act.

After some argument, learned counsel for the
petitioner seeks liberty to file representation before the

Superintendent of Police, Samastipur in the light of ***Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar and others*** passed in ***Cr.W.J.C. No. 153 of 2017*** with analogous cases decided on 09.09.2022.
