2 10-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Excise P.R. Case No. 131 of 2023, registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016, (as amended 2022).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence.
Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious
possession of this petitioner. Petitioner is the driver of the seized
vehicle. He has no concern with the seized liquor. Petitioner is
in custody since 09.02.2023.

Learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for
bail.



Considering the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner, his period of custody, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum Special Judge, Excise-II, Kaimur at Bhabhua in connection with Excise P. R. Case No. 131 of 2023.

This is also subject to the conditions that (I) the petitioner would cooperate in the proceeding of the court below. The trial court is directed to expedite the trial of all the cases which are registered against the petitioner. In the event of failure to appear on two consecutive dates, the court below will be at liberty to pass appropriate order including cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner and (ii) the petitioner shall mark his presence in Excise P. R. District- Kaimur at Bhabhua on first Sunday of every month, failing which, his bail bonds shall be cancelled by the court below.
