seeking the following relief:-

*“1. i) For issuance of a writ in the
nature of Mandamus, commanding
the respondents to include the
name of petitioner in select list
which has been published by the
Central Selection Board,Bihar, Patna
(Police Recruitment) for the post of
Constables.*

*ii)For direction upon the
respondents to select the petitioner*



on the post of Constable after inclusion of his name in the selection list.

iii) For declaration that petitioner was suitable for being selected but the respondents did not include his name in the final selection list.”
