2 22-03-2023 Though the present writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of the order dated 13.02.2023, passed by the Circle Officer, Rahui, Nalanda, in connection with Encroachment case no. 13 of 2022-23, however, at the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to file appropriate appeal under ***Section 11 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956***. Liberty so sought, is granted.



It is needless to state that for a period of four weeks from today, *status quo* existing as on today *qua* the houses of the petitioners in question shall be maintained for enabling the petitioners to file appropriate appeal and seek interim orders.

The writ petition stands disposed off, however, with the aforesaid liberty.
