following relief:-

*“1. That this application is being filed for issuance
of a writ in nature of mandamus commanding the
Respondent authorities to consider the appointment

grounds in place of his father who died in honners
during service working in the Central Bank of India
in Sitamarhi Branch as clerk.”*
