2 26-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 344, 342, 353, 186, 188, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleges that 13 named accused persons including the petitioner along with 100-150 unknown, were raising slogan in a procession and had blocked the road at Amba Chowk.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and is aged about 68 years

Learned counsel for the petitioner next submits that



the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, it is next submitted that he resides near Amba Chowk and thus had come out of his house to see the procession when he also came to be implicated when admittedly, petitioner being a senior before institution of the present FIR, was a person with clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Amba P.S. Case No. 220 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
