A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioner no.2 (Meena Devi) apprehends her arrest in connection with Madhepur P.S. Case No.291 of 2022 registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a)(b)(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner, who is a lady. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged seized liquor. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above named petitioner no.2 be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge (Excise Act), Jhanjharpur, Madhubani in connection with Madhepur P.S. Case No.291 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
