2 24-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that this petitioner committed theft in the house of informant after breaking the lock of door.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and only on suspicion, he has been made accused. No stolen article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No. 373 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
