2 17-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody in a
case registered for the offences punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 147.375 litres of illicit
Indian made foreign liquor from a Bolero vehicle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner is innocent and he has falsely
been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The
petitioner has no concern either with the seized vehicle



or the illicit liquor. The petitioner is languishing in custody since 31.12.2022. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousands) in the District Legal Services Authority, Gaya.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1, Gaya in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 798 of 2022.
