2 15-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act.

It is alleged that 51 liters of mahua wine was
recovered from motorcycle Reg. No. BR 44D3999.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. Petitioner is neither owner nor driver of the
motorcycle. Petitioner's name has figured during course of
investigation in confessional statement of co-accused
Veerbahadur Ram. No incriminating material has been



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he is no way connected with the aforesaid recovery. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

Considering the facts of the case, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1st Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Bihiya Police Station Case No 102 of 2020, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
