Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for  
the offence punishable under section 366(A) of the Indian Penal  
Code.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner enticed the  
the daughter of the informant and took her away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
victim in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. denied the  
prosecution case. She stated that she had left her house at her  
own sweet will and solemnized marriage with the petitioner.  
The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the bail petition  
of the petitioner.



Considering the statement of the victim made under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and other facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., Hilsa, District- Nalanda in connection with Chandi P.S. Case No. 381 of 2022 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
