5 23-02-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“That this petition is for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus commanding/directing the Respondents to grant compensation to the family of deceased mother of the petitioner namely Sugiya Devi who has died from heat stroke after setting aside



order dated 05.11.19 issued by Sub-Divisional Public Grievance Redressal officer, Gaya Whereby and whereunder compensation of Rupees Four Lakhs has been denied to be awarded to the family of victims of heatstroke in the District of Gaya, and further for setting aside appellate appellate order passed in appeal bearing no-435110101101905887/IA dated 08.11.19 which was heard and rejected by the Divisional Commissioner-Cum-Appellate Authority, Magadh Division, Gaya on 5.12.2019 and/or issuance of appropriate writ/writs, or grant of other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner may be deemed entitled under the law in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to pursue his claim before the respondent authorities. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The present writ petition stands dismissed
