2      04-07-2023      Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he is involved in the murder of the mother-in-law of the informant by strangulating her with rope.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that the informant is not an eye-witness of the alleged occurrence. He further submits that the



petitioner is aged about 19 years and is a student. He further submits that there is a family dispute between the parties. There is no specific overt act against the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as there is no specific overt act against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Mahua P.S. Case No.419 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
