- 2 15-09-2023 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing CWJC No.367 of 2021, which has stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution by an order dated 20.07.2022.

submitted that since the counsel for the petitioner was engaged in another Court, he could not appear when the case was called out for hearing, hence, the aforesaid petition was dismissed on account of non- prosecution.
