seeking the following relief:-

“1. That, a writ is being filed for the issuance of appropriate writ or writs order, orders direction for given to the learned Munsif Court, Banka in which the respondent (Defendant no. 3 Niranjan Thakur) has filed a counter claim and written statement in which signature of respondent/Defendant No. 3 of the learned Court below alleged that the signature of the defendant no. 3 is differ which is being of the court below and the plaintiff Soni Devi
