The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders in the nature of MANDAMUS, directing and commanding the respondents concerned to discharge the statutory obligation to compute and make



payment of entire arrears of salary including current salary to the petitioner along with interest @ 12% per annum, pending since October, 2001 to till 14th May, 2014) and onward (for about more than 71 months) along with other allowances permissible in view of the 4, 5th and 6th Pay Revision Commission's Report and further for any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner may be entitled in accordance with law.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to file appropriate petition before the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-Chief Executive Officer, District Board (Zila Parishad), Sitamarhi, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case, appropriate petition is filed before the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-Chief Executive Officer, District Board (Zila Parishad), Sitamarhi, within a period of three weeks from today, the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-Chief Executive Officer, District Board (Zila Parishad), Sitamarhi, shall consider the same, in accordance with law and pass a reasoned and a speaking order, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.



4. The present writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
