Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 447, 341, 323, 354(B), 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that the petitioner is younger brother of the husband of the informant. He submits that the injury found upon the victim is simple in nature. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner and informant is family member. He further submits that petitioner has two criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for



bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Phulparas P.S. Case No. 500 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
