“1. i. To direct the respondent authority to grant the ACP and MACP benefits and thereafter revised the pay and pension of the petitioner and also pay the differences of the salary as well as revised pension of the petitioner with compound interest.

ii. To further direct the respondent authority to grant increment in salary after 31.08.04 to 31.01.2017

*iii. To further direct the respondent
authority to grant retirement
benefits including G.P.F, P.F.,
Gratuity and any other benefits.”*
