following relief:-

“1. That this application under writ jurisdiction of  
Hon’ble Court is being filed for issuance of an  
appropriate writ, order and / or direction to quash  
the order dated 7.8.2014, passed by the  
Respondent Regional Development Officer,  
Purnea Division in Misc. Appeal No. 63 of 2013  
dismissing the appeal preferred against the order  
dated 29.02.2012 passed by the learned  
respondent District Programme Officer in Case  
No. 43 of 2012-13 whereby and whereunder  
petitioner has been dismissed from the post of  
Anganbari Sevika on the ground of failure on her



part to distribute Ration on 21.01.2012 as well as for staying the operation of impugned order and respondent authorities be restrained from taking any further steps for appointing Anganbari Sevika in Anganbari Centre No. 167, Sheikhpura Block Kadwa in the district of Katihar till the disposal of instant writ application.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
