3 28-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 420, 286, 387, 120B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per FIR, the allegation against unknown accused persons including this petitioner is that they looted three mobile phones, cash of Rs. 29,000/- and one gold chain, one silver ring from the informant and his friend and they also got transferred Rs. 2,00,000/ from his account in different their accounts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has



falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence and he has not been put on TIP and nothing looted article has been recovered from his conscious possession. It is further submitted that during the investigation nothing consistent material has come against the petitioner. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 20.10.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Majorganj P.S. Case No. 318 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Ist Sitamarhi.
