Pursuant to the last order dated 13.07.2023, a supplementary show cause has been filed on behalf of the opposite party no. 3 to 5. The cheques of Rs. 2,17,993/- in favour of the petitioner has come in his account.

He however has grievance that on what basis the said amount was paid is not clear and a chart should have also been made available to him

In that view of the matter, the Registrar, Tilka Manjhi Bhagalpur University is required to entertain the petitioner on 31.07.2023 at 3:00 P.M. in his chamber and provide him the chart to show the amount that has been calculated.

If, still aggrieved, the petitioner has remedy to challenge the same before the appropriate court.
