2 24-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Desari P.S. Case No. 424 of 2022 registered under Section 363/365/366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and later on section 4/8 of the POCSO Act was added.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. Further he submits that in the instant case, First Information Report is lodged after lapse of three days of the alleged occurrence. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the



event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-VI-cum-Special Judge, POCSO, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Desari P.S. Case No. 424 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.

Permission is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to make necessary correction in course of the day.
