3 26-04-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 307, 302, 504/34 of the IPC and section 27 of the Arms Act.

Vide order dated 29.03.2023, a report was called for, regarding the stage of trial. In compliance thereof, a report sent by learned Additional District Sessions Judge-IX, Gopalganj dated 28.02.2023, is kept at flag 'R', whereby it is stated that the presently the case is pending for evidence and statement u/s 313 Cr.P.C. and the time likely to be taken in conclusion of the trial is about three months, if parties co-operate.

Considering the submissions made in the report, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner named above. The prayer



for bail is hereby rejected.

Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed.

However, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
