2. This appeal has been filed for setting aside order dated 06.02.2023 , passed in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 148 , 149, 341, 342, 343 , 427, 504, 506, 385/34 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3(i)(r)(s)(w) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act, whereby the prayer for anticipatory bail of the appellant has been rejected.

3. As per the prosecution case , these appellants along with other co-accused persons attacked the police force and also assaulted them as a result of which some of the police personnel sustained injury .

4. Considering the fact that these appellants have hindered the police party in discharging their duties and also assaulted them on account of which police personnel sustained injury , I do not find any reason to interfere with the



impugned order, accordingly this appeal is dismissed.
