2 31-08-2023 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application praying for issuance of an appropriate Writ/ Order or Direction, in the nature of a Writ of Certiorari or any other appropriate Writ/ Order or Direction, for quashing the Advertisement No,01/ 2015 as issued in the English Daily Hindustan Times" on 25.6.2015 and in the Hindi Daily "Hindustan" on 26.6.2015 in so far as it purports to fill all 14 posts of Reporter, including the post held by Petitioner, as the Petitioner, pursuant to his appointment has



neither been removed nor any order of termination has been issued or communicated till date; The Petitioner further prays for a consequential Writ/ Order or Direction, in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ/ Order or Direction, commanding the Respondents to confirm the Petitioner in service from the date of his initial appointment i.e 23.8.2005, with all consequential benefits such as continuity, arrears of pay and allowances etc, as has been done in cases of similarly situated persons, in accordance with Law.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
