3 16-08-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following reliefs:-

*“1.(a) A writ is in nature of mandamus or any other
appropriate writ order/s direction to the respondent
authority to promote the petitioner from Assistant
Grade-I (Depot) to Manager (Depot) and with all
consequential benefit for which he entitle too.*

*(b) For issuance of any other appropriate writ, order
or direction which your lordship may deem fit and
proper in the fact and circumstances of the case.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner
seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks
liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative



remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
