following reliefs:-

*“1(i) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the
nature of Mandamus or any appropriate writ to
quash the order dated 26-08-2014 passed by
Respondent no. 2 by which the petitioner has
been declared dis-qualified in PST in 1600
meter race held on 19-03-2014.*

*(ii) For issuance of an order or direction
directing the respondents to conduct a fresh
1600 meter race and verify the claim of the
petitioner who has qualified in 1600 meter race
held on 19-03-2014.”*
