2 26-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 354, 308, 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are persons with clean antecedent and are women and are alleged to have assaulted the informant with fists and legs.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case, it is



next submitted that though injury has been suffered by the informant, but then the allegation of assault causing injury is not against the present petitioners.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Balia P.S. Case No. 158 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
