A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehends their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are person with clean antecedent and on account of land dispute the occurrence took place wherein the informant alleges that petitioner No. 1 assaulted him by sword causing injury on his head while petitioner No. 2 assaulted him by an iron rod.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the



petitioners have been falsely implicated on account of land dispute.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners and submits that there is specific allegation of assault against the petitioner further the impugned order itself records that the injury suffered by the injured is grievous in nature.

Considering the submission made by the learned APP for the State, the Court is not inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the present anticipatory bail application is rejected.
