ORAL ORDER

- 2 25-08-2023 1. The present petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs :-

“(i) For issuance of writ of Mandamus commanding the respondent authority to allow the petitioners to take part in Medical Fitness test for appointment on the post of Kakshpal Prison of Advertisement no. 10/2013 similar to others who have been successfully passed in written examination and were earlier recommended and for medical test but the same was stayed but now in fresh medical test, they have not been called for medical Fitness test which is going on from 18.08.2015 to 13.08.2015.

(ii) For issuance of writ of Mandamus



commanding the respondent authority not to discriminate among the successful candidates for medical test.

(iii) For issuance of direction to make proper enquiry of fresh result on which respondent authority going to conduct medical test from 10.08.2015 to 13.08.2015 for appointment of Kakshpal of Jail in the light of Advertisement no. 10/2013. ”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to avail such other alternative remedies, as are otherwise available under the law for redressal of their grievances. Liberty so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
