APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act and Sections 8/20(B)(ii)(A) of the NDPS Act.

As per FIR, it is alleged that the petitioner was apprehended on the spot and on search one live cartridge and one motorcycle were recovered from his possession. It is further alleged that several incriminating article were also recovered from co-accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has



falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery nor from co-accused persons rather alleged recovered motorcycle belongs to the petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 06.04.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 73818 of 2022. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 30.10.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Runnisaipur P.S. Case No. 669 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge SC/ST(POA), Sitamarhi.
