2 16-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 658.125 litres of liquor from a pickup van.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that one Vijay Yadav is owner of pickup van and earlier this petitioner was his driver but later he left his employment, as such petitioner is not the owner of the pickup



one, but then since he was earlier associated with Vijay Yadav as such photostat copy of his license was in the vehicle based on which he came to be implicated when admittedly petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mokama P.S. Case No. 415 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
