- 5 07-11-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned APP along with Mr. Harsh Singh, learned counsel for OP No. 2.
2. The petitioners in compliance of the order dated 31-10-2023 are present.
3. The learned counsel for the OP No. 2 submits that the OP No. 2 could not come to the court on account of her advanced age. The learned counsel for the OP No. 2 next submits that he has instructions to make submissions that OP No. 2 does not oppose the quashing application, as the dispute in between the petitioners and the OP No. 2 has been compromised. It is further submitted that petitioner No. 2 is son of OP No. 2 and petitioner No. 1 is her daughter-in-law.
