2 14-07-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411
and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the informant
alleges that apprehended accused who committed theft in the
shop of the petitioner disclosed the name of the petitioner who
had fled.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, it is
next submitted that he was not arrested from the spot as such,
nothing was recovered from his conscious possession. It is



further submitted that he came to be implicated based on confessional statement of the apprehended accused in police custody which does not have any evidentiary value, when admittedly petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mehandia P.S. Case No. 253 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
