Heard Mr. Gyanendra Kumar Shukla, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Mr. Saroj Kumar Sharma, learned AC to AAG-3 appearing on behalf of the State, Mr. Ram Yash Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Accountant General, Bihar and Mr. Amit Singh, learned counsel for the respondent nos. 4 and 6.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that in spite of the petitioner having filed



detailed representation before the Additional Director General of Police (Budget, Appeal and Welfare), Police Head Quarter, DGP Head Quarter, Bihar, Patna, he has not taken any action for making payment of retiral benefits on different heads.

3. A query has also been made on behalf of the Accountant General, Bihar vide letter no. GEN No : 1900/2022-2023, still no reply to the query has been sent to the Accountant General, Bihar, by the Deputy Inspector General of Police (Vigilance Investigation Bureau), Government of Bihar, Patna.

4. Considering the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner, if so advised, may file a comprehensive representation with respect to the relief as claimed for in the present writ petition before the Deputy Inspector General of Police, (Vigilance Investigation Bureau), Government of Bihar, Patna.

5. The Deputy Inspector General of Police, (Vigilance Investigation Bureau), Government of Bihar, Patna, is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner in light of 'Annexure-1' series, the communication made by the office of the Accountant General, Bihar, with regard to payments of retiral benefits.

6. The representation of the petitioner is required to



be disposed of after verifying the service record and all other evidences so as to give satisfactory reply to the query made on behalf of the Accountant General, Bihar, for expeditiously disposal of grievance of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of filing of the representation in accordance with law taking into account that the petitioner had superannuated on 31.07.2021 from the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

7. With above observation and direction, the present writ petition is disposed of.
